### **Health Forms - Important!**

As we move closer to the event, we now require electronic health forms to be completed for all young people.

The primary leader on EMS has the ability to see which participants have completed their forms. You can view the completed forms, download a group medical/InTouch report, and re-send the parent sign-up link if it's been lost.

Health forms are also available for leaders and we strongly advise that they are completed.

## Campsites

We are now in the process of allocating camping space. Please ensure you speak with your subcamp leader if you have any participants or leaders with mobility issues, or similar requirements meaning that you need a pitch near to the facilities. Please also let your subcamp leader know if you have anybody who uses a wheelchair, so that we can ensure appropriate transport arrangements are in place for the off-site activities.

## Early Heads-Up - Traffic Management

We wanted to give you some early information about some of the traffic management measures we will be taking for Suffolk Punch.

With over 1000 people now involved in this event, we have had to come up with a sensible traffic management plan to ensure that people and vehicles can enter and exit the site in a safe and efficient manner. Nobody likes being stuck in a queue!

We are adopting a system similar to that which is in use at Scouts HQ at Gilwell Park.

Below is an outline of the measures.

### **We will publish full instructions in a future update.**

#### Arrivals and Departures (people).

All groups camping on site will be allocated to one of three arrival and departure time slots. Details of your time slots and information about participant drop-off and pick-up will be given in the July leader update which will be published a couple of days after the leader Zoom call.

#### Arrivals and Departures (equipment).

We are asking all groups to deliver the bulk of their equipment to site before the arrivals day. Please make every effort to do so, as this will greatly support us in getting people on site efficiently. Some districts have arranged a van to pick up large equipment in advance of the event, you might like to do the same. All groups are welcome to pitch a mess tent and leave equipment within from Tuesday 9th August. Please let your subcamp leader know when you'll be doing this. The site will have a 24/7 presence during the build week, so your kit will be kept secure.

#### Parking

No vehicles will be permitted to park on the main site for the duration of the camp.

We will have a satellite car park in operation. This will be a very short distance from Hallowtree. A shuttle bus will be running between the main site and the car park for the duration of the event, although it's only an 8 minute walk. Leader vehicles, group vans, trailers and minibuses will need to park there once unloaded. The satellite car park has a single access gate which will be manned by event staff during the day, and will be locked overnight. There will be security lighting and a licensed SIA security guard covering the car park all night. Don't worry, you'll be able to get access 24/7 if you need to use your vehicle in an emergency.

A small amount of disabled parking will be available on site but prior notice must be given to the event team, and evidence of a blue badge will be needed.
