## Arrivals and Departures - Important!

On **Thursday 11th August**, gates to Suffolk Punch open at **9am** with participant arrivals starting from **10am**.

Each group attending has been allocated a time slot to arrive, please find this above. This is to ensure smooth traffic flow on and around the venue.

If your group is unable to stick to the time slot given for reasons beyond your control, please contact your subcamp leader to advise them when you will be arriving.

Equipment drop-off is possible on the Thursday, but no vehicles will be permitted to park on the main site for the duration of the camp and the site must be clear of vehicles by **6pm**.

The entrance to the site will be clearly marked from the main road. If you are using a satnav, use postcode **IP10 0JP**.

Departure times are also allocated above and we ask that you do your best to adhere to these where possible. Please contact the team if it's an issue.

Your Sub Camp Team will be there to look after you during the duration of the event. They will be there to meet you on arrival day and help with any question or queries you may have.

Signing-in will be done on subcamps. Each group will be provided with a package containing participant goodies (including wristbands) and full instructions on completing the sign-in process.

## Parking Reminder

We will have a satellite car park in operation. This will be a very short distance from Hallowtree. A shuttle bus will be running between the main site and the car park for the duration of the event, although it's only an 8-minute walk. Leader vehicles, group vans, trailers and minibuses will need to park there once unloaded. The satellite car park has a single access gate which will be manned by event staff during the day, and will be locked overnight with a licensed SIA security guard covering the car park all night.

A small amount of disabled parking will be available on site but prior notice must be given to the event team, and evidence of a blue badge will be needed. Please email [info@suffolkpunch.co.uk](mailto:info@suffolkpunch.co.uk) if you require a parking pass for the main car park.

## **Cooking on Site - Important!**

Please note, all cooking must be done using gas cookers.

**Open fires or liquid fuel burners (petrol, paraffin etc.) are NOT permitted.**

## **Programme**

Activities run from Friday to Sunday, starting at 09:00, through to 13:00, break for lunch and then from 14:00 to 17:00. Some activities may operate outside of these times. There will also be various activities and entertainment available in the evenings for everyone to enjoy.

***Ticketing*** - To help us manage offsite activities more effectively we will be running a Ticketing System for water activities. All groups have been allocated a time slot for their time on the water. This time can be found above. A ticket will guarantee participants access to the activity at their specific time, but participants are able to queue up for the activity again without a ticket, filling in spaces as available.

All other activities will be operated on a queueing basis. Please encourage your young people to spread out and explore all corners of the site.
